

## ACUTE MEDICAL EMERGENCIES

The course is standardized course teaching evidence-based resuscitation guidelines and skills to healthcare professionals.

### Who is this course suitable for?

The course is designed for healthcare professionals who would be expected to apply the skills taught as part of their clinical duties, or to teach them on a regular basis. Appropriate participants include doctors, paramedics and nurses working in acute care areas or on resuscitation /medical emergency/ICU outreach teams. All applicants must hold a professional healthcare qualification or be in training for a professional healthcare qualification.

### Learning outcomes

The course teaches the knowledge and skills required to:

- recognize and treat the deteriorating patient using a structured ABCDE approach;
- deliver standardized CPR in adults;
- manage a cardiac arrest by working with a multidisciplinary team in an emergency situation;
- utilize non-technical skills to facilitate strong team leadership and effective team membership;
- deliver prompt and accurate assessment of critically ill patients, including monitoring, measurement and interpretation;
- effectively manage acute medical emergencies.

### The course objectives include:

- use the structured ABCDE approach,
- resuscitation,
- airway management,
- intravenous access.

### Course structure

The course is run over one day.
